WP 5 Transnational meetings and training sessions

Summary

The project involved the active collaboration of five international organizations – DAS ARAD (Romania), IVI INTERNATIONAL (Italy), OPEI (Cyprus), ORIENSYS (France), and Celiz International (Romania) – to achieve common goals in the fields of online social education and e-learning.  - 100% rated communication and cooperation as excellent.
 - **Impact on Skills:**
 - 96% of participants stated they gained new knowledge in e-learning.
 - 100% expressed their intention to continue collaboration after the project's conclusion.
